Where a microchip is not found or the registered details do not match those of a claimant, the process is much more complicated and can result in delays. You will be asked to provide proof that you are the legal keeper which may include, recent veterinary registration/bills, a purchase receipt as well as proof of address and recent photographs. Council approval may also be required. 2. PAY FEES & CHARGES All Local Authorities set fees & charges, which they require the dog owner to pay in full before a dog is released.
